Section XXX – EVENT RULES – STEER WRESTLING – 5. D.

Currently reads- “Hazers must have a valid HRA membership.”

Amend to read- “Hazers must have a valid HRA membership or sign a waiver for each rodeo they participate at.”

Section III – MEMBERSHIPS – PEE WEES – 5. c

Motion to edit the wording in the rule book as follows:

“Pee Wee members will be 12 and under as of January 1st that rodeo year. The Pee Wee membership applies to Pee Wee Barrels only. To compete in any other events a Junior Membership must be purchased. The member may compete with the Pee Wee membership (barrels only) and the Junior Membership for all other events.”

Rationale

There are no age divisions for goat tying, breakaway etc. if a pee wee member wants to try another event like goat tying they should be able to enter that event without changing age divisions for barrels. I am assuming the original rule is in place because the Pee Wee's don't pay a membership & the free membership is intended for Pee Wee Barrels only. The rule is most

likely to prevent **Pee Wees** with a free membership from competing in multiple events on the free membership - which I agree should be the case. Therefore I propose they should purchase the youth membership to enter other events that don't have an age category (like goat tying) but could remain in pee wee barrels according to their age.

SECTION XXVII – TROPHIES AND AWARDS

SECTION XIV – STOCK CONTRACTOR GUIDELINES

rule 1. a. Current: The annual dues payable for a stock contractor is the same as a senior membership - **\$75** plus GST

SECTION XVI - rule 2

SECTION XVI - rule 12

Current: All timed event stock will be drawn no later than 2 hours before the performance. If there are no judges to do the draw at that time, then the event directors will be responsible to make a fair draw

Proposed: All timed event stock will be drawn no later than 1 hours before the performance. If there are no judges to do the draw at that time, then the event directors will be responsible to make a fair draw

--conflicts with section XXX, Tie Down Roping, 5.b. as well as 1 hour is plenty of time for members to see which stock they have drawn.

Current: The draw is to be made at least 2 hours before rodeo time.

3. Entry fees for major events with added money less than \$500 will be \$35. Rodeos with added money of \$500 or over will have entry fees of \$50.

Eligible contestants for breakaway roping include

- a. Female contestants of any age
- b. Junior boys (16 years and under as of Jan 1 of that rodeo year), as long as not cross-entered in tie down roping in that rodeo.
